**COURSER ABILITY TEST:** Offered to all dogs, AKC registered, PAL, ILP or Canine Partner (mixed breeds) in the AKC program. Dogs over 12" must complete a course of 600 yards with 4 turns; for dogs under 12" , the course is 300 yards with 4 turns. For complete rules and requirements visit [akc.org](http://akc.org).

**C.A.T. Title:** Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times. These are suffix title that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower level of title.

**Coursing Ability (CA)** - Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test 3 times under at least two different judges.

**Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA)**- Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 10 times.

**Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX )** - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 25 times.

**Coursing Ability Excellent 2 (CAX2)** - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 50 times. A higher numbered title will be awarded for every additional 25 passes.

### How to use Test Entry Forms & Canine Partner Forms

Please remember to complete a separate entry form for each dog, for each event. Unlike conformation show entry forms you must use a separate form for each event and each dog. Thus, if you enter a dog for each of the CAT event you will need fo fill out 3 separate entry forms. Entry forms are available on the Cascade Coursing Club website:

If you have a mixed breed dog or a dog that is otherwise ineligible for AKC registration you can enroll the dog with the AKC Canine Partners listing. You can enroll your dog at the test site by completing the Canine Partner form in this premium. The payment for this must be a separate check payable to American Kennel Club which we will submit with your entry form.

### PARKING:

If you are not entered in the agility trial and coming for the coursing tests only please watch for the lure coursing signs and enter Argus Ranch at the second driveway on the left. Please park along The fence line.

### **COURSING ABILITY TEST:**

**What must a dog do to pass the C.A.T?** The coursing Ability Test (C.A.T.) is a pass/fail. During a Test the dog runs the course once without any dogs. Because safety is of the utmost importance, the C.A.T. takes into consideration the individual dog pursuing qualification and therefore has two different course length to accommodate the type and size of the entrant. In either case, dogs will chase a lure made of plastic strips.

**Dogs Less Than 12" Tall & "Flat Faced" Dogs.** Any entrant that is less than 12" tall at the withers and /or brachycephalic shall run a 300-yard course with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 300-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  minutes

**Dogs More Than 12" Tall.** Any entrant that is taller than 12" at the withers and not brachycephalics shall run a 600-yard course (or as close to 600 yard as possible) with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 600-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 2 minutes.

In order to pass, the dog must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time for the course length. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance.

If there is a question which course a dog should run, the judge will decide.

#### **General Rules:**

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
2. Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded.
3. Dogs will be inspected before each Event.
4. Dogs will run "naked" with out collars or harnesses. Muzzles are allowed.
5. Electric continuous loop machines will be used. Backup systems will consist of a gasoline and /or electric powered drag lure machines. Lure will consist of white plastic bags.
6. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and or field conditions on the day of the trial.
7. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive hounds form the event site.
8. There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.
9. NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
10. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

**Directions:** From Argus Ranch – turn right from the Argus driveway, then left on Green Valley Rd for about 7 miles. Turn left on Auburn – Black Diamond road for about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile to the entrance to Hwy 18 West. Take Hwy 18 about 1.5 miles to the Auburn Way exit. Take a left at on Auburn way and drive for about 2 blocks to the clinic.

## **QUALIFIED COURSER TEST-**

A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed or another breed with a similar running style (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certification is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

### **Eligible Breeds & Registry**

Lure Coursing tests shall be open to eligible breeds one year of age or older.

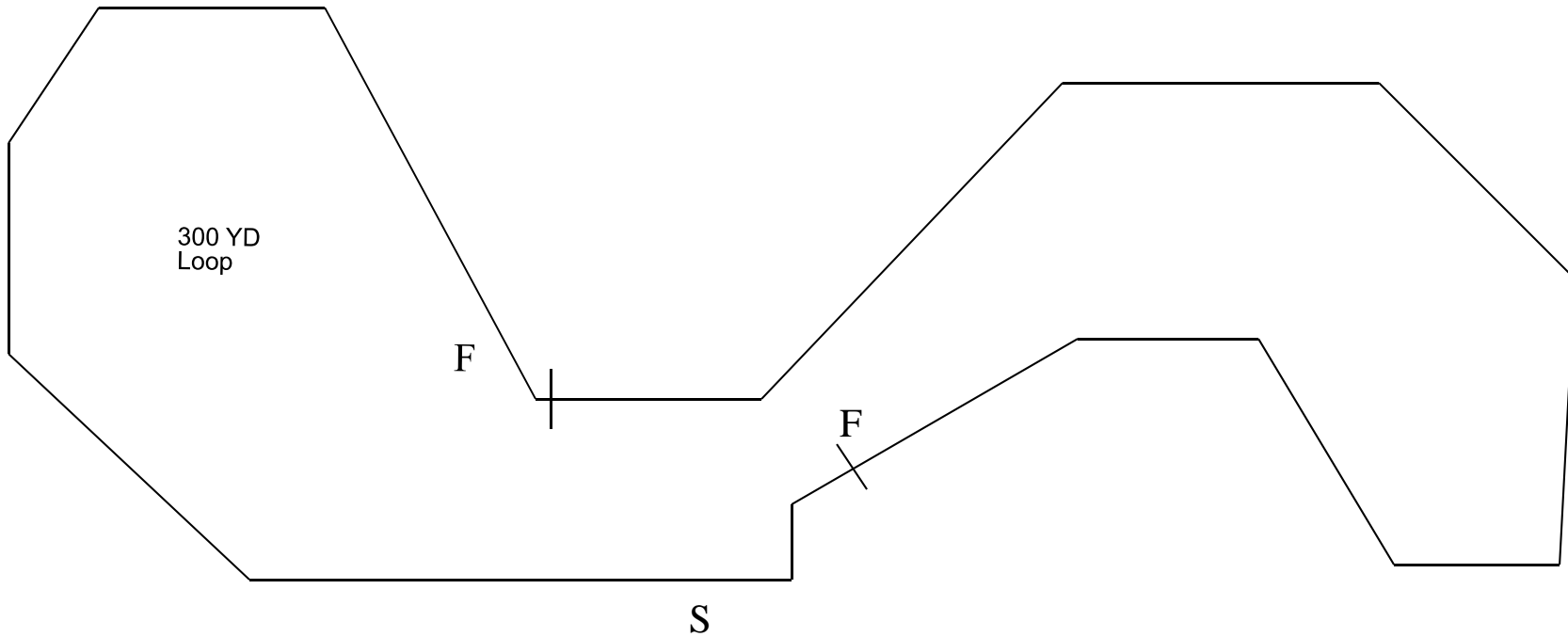
Course will be reversed for PM Tests

CAT; dogs under 12" will run 300 yards with minimum of 4 turns, none > 90 degrees.

Qualified Courser Certs; dogs will run at least 600 yards with a minimum of 4 turns, none >90 degrees.

The start and finish will be reversed for test 2.
